Title

Social capital and human-made disaster: Exploring the displacement of the survivors of Rana Plaza collapse in Bangladesh

Abstract

Disaster survivors have not only practiced a vulnerable situation, but they may also have been concurrently displaced to places usually unknown to them. This study is aimed at analyzing the impact of human-made disaster on the social capital of the disaster victims and survivors. The study is based on the conduction of two Focus Group Discussions (FDG) and 10 Case Studies of the survivors. Thereafter, I analyzed the results according to the societal background of each victim, especially as it relates to social capital. The analysis shows that each factor involved in the interplay among the different processes that produced the changes in the affected people's quality of life is at the same time a damaged asset, a vulnerability factor and a resource to draw upon for coping. This study is also based on experiences of the survivors; it attempts to understand how social capital of survivors damaged or stopped aftermath of the disaster and rebuild their lives and communities. The paper with the title: “Social capital of survivors aftermath of the human-induced disaster in the context of Rana Plaza collapse in Bangladesh” is a very interesting paper where the frequency of disasters increases. But, the manuscript does not meet the standard of Journal of Social Sciences (JSS) requirements. The writing format does not comply with the JSS format, also supporting information (Acknowledgement, Funding Information, Author Contributions,

and Conflict of Interest) is not equipped. So the authors must revise this manuscript according to the standard requirement. I suggest the authors see the papers that have been published by JSS. Please check citation format and English/grammar/spelling throughout the whole paper.



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
