As the organizing committee, we are proud to inform that **8th OIC Halal Expo and 7th World Halal Summit** in association with the **Islamic Centre for Development of Trade (ICDT)**, the **Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC)** and the **Standards and Metrology for Islamic Countries (SMIIC)**, will be held on **25-28 November, 2021 in Istanbul Congress Center, Istanbul-Turkey**, under the theme of **“New Era & New Normals: Necessity of Halal Production and Consumption”**.

8th OIC Halal Expo simultaneously with 7th World Halal Summit provides the unique climate for the exchange of expertise and experience between participants and the group of researchers and experts in all areas related to the definition of Halal (e.g. Halal food & beverage, halal cosmetics & personal care, halal tourism & accommodation, Islamic banking & finance, textile & modest fashion etc.).

The official statistics of the 7th OIC Halal Expo revealed that the event hosted by 34.865 trade visitors from 94 countries, 378 exhibitors from 35 countries that shared their invaluable experience during the exhibition on innovations and developments related to halal industry.

World Halal Summit is established for the aspiration of providing an overview of the world's latest developments and trends about halal and discussing future directions to be taken within the halal market. The 5th World Halal Summit 2019 which has been attended by more than 9000 delegates from 94 countries, hosted 67 senior speakers from 25 countries that projected to promote new prospects for further advancement of the Halal world.

Despite the COVID-19 outbreak in 2020, the **6th edition of World Halal Summit** was successfully organized in association with SMIIC on 21-23 December, 2020, in Istanbul, Turkey in a hybrid format simultaneously with **virtual e-Halal Expo 2020**.

Regardless of all the unfavorable conditions in the time of pandemic, 6th World Halal Summit hosted 61 speakers from 15 different countries and the sessions were followed by 9217 people from 55 different countries both physically and virtually via social media accounts. Hosted Buyer Program which is supported by the Ministry of Trade of Republic of Turkey will be held as a side-event and this exceptional trade business event will facilitate the conclusion of dozens of contracts between the companies involved in halal business, as the program aims at bringing more professional buyers in order to offer new business cooperation opportunities to the participating countries.

Previous edition of Hosted Buyers program hosted 474 buyers from 47 countries who participated in 7110 B2B meetings.
