Authors are encouraged to carefully consider the reviewers' comments and suggestions for improvement of your manuscript, such as:

1. In the introduction, it is not explained what problems arise in class, so this research needs to be done.

2. The main problem is in the findings that do not show RME and DR.

3. Please provide reasons why the tasks are varied and did not follow the cyclical process in DR?

4. In the research methods section, the authors do not explain the research instruments used, how the authors built the instruments, how the validity of the instruments used, and how the data analysis process was carried out.

5. The development of the task for the next class or TE should be based on the analysis and reflection of the previous experiment.

6. The supported task in the learning process provided by researchers does not allow the horizontal and vertical mathematical processes to occur.

7. Why did the group/ level of students are different, from Grade 5 to grade 4? Was there any difference in skill/ability?

8. From the results of the analysis of student work, some of the students' answers do not indicate where students can conclude the formal answers that are obtained, so that, in effect, students are able to solve problems with formal solutions and do not require support drawings prepared by researchers.

9. The RME was not elaborated fully here, like the tenets and or characteristics.

10. The material developed in this research process is not in accordance with the characteristics of the RME.

11. In the process of analyzing data, the researcher does not make a connection between the basic theory developed and the constructed HLT.

12. Please make sure that your discussion section is suitable and supported by a reputable journal.

13. The "result and discussion" section reports must have the most important findings, including results, analyze as appropriate.

14. The paper must refer to several papers in the Journal on Mathematics Education that are suitable for your research, especially about RME and DR.

15. Please add more suitable references for at least 30 references from the reputable international journal, not be older than 10 years, with their DOI.

16. The manuscript should also have been carefully revised and similarity check no more than 20% (Recapitulation the contents of the revised article and similarity check result file must be attached as supplementary file in revision submission process).
